Introduction

Scope

- Geographic Data: Approximate geographic location.

Use of Data

We use your data to:

- Communicate with you.
- Process payments.
- Ensure security.
- Comply with legal obligations.

Sharing Data

We share data with:

- Educational partners.
- Service providers (e.g., payment processors).
- Business partners.
- Analytics and advertising providers.
- For legal compliance and safety.

Security

We use appropriate security measures to protect your data. However, no system is completely secure, so it's important to protect your password and notify us of any unauthorized access.

Your Rights

You have rights to access, correct, delete, and restrict the processing of your data. You can also opt out of certain data uses, such as promotional communications.

Children's Privacy

Our Services are not intended for children under 13. We do not knowingly collect data from children under 13 without parental consent.
